Why should I order a Court Appointed Special Advocates Specialty Plate (Big Voices for Little Texans)

When home is no longer safe for a child, and the child must enter the foster care system, a judge may appoint a committed volunteer called a CASA or court appointed special advocate®. The volunteer's focus is on that child, giving hope and help in guiding the child to a safe, permanent home. Proceeds from these attractive plates directly benefit your local CASA program that recruits, trains, and supports CASA volunteers.

How much does the license plate cost?

A single set costs \$30 while personalized sets cost \$70, both in addition to regular registration fees.

How much of the proceeds from the license plates go directly to my CASA program?

Of the \$30 from each license plate, \$22 comes to Texas CASA and \$11 to the local CASA program.

How do I know which CASA programs will benefit from my license plate purchase?

The CASA program in your county of residence (or the address where your plates are registered) is the local program that will benefit from your license plate purchase.

When can I get the Court Appointed Special Advocate plate?
